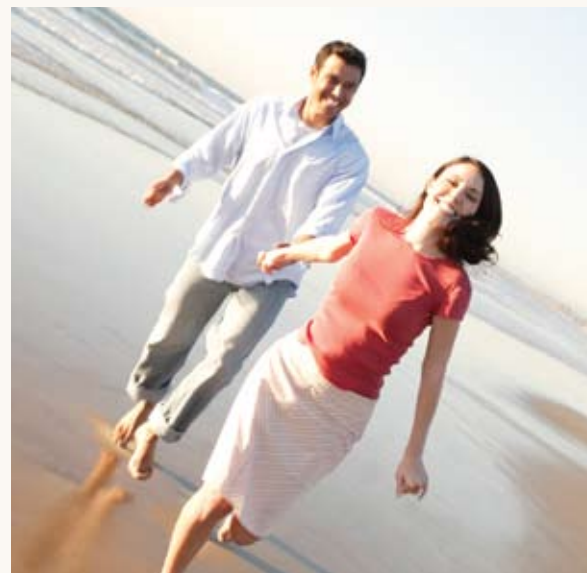


Access America Advantage: Top 10 Reasons to Buy Travel Insurance
